## From the Pastor's Desk / Del Escritorio del Padre

While reflecting on the Gospel passage on the Glorious second coming of Jesus we considered the importance of:

- Reading the signs of the times

- Beware of the distractive forces of this world that constantly unsettle our genuine faith life

- recognize their impact and influence on our thinking, living, and our very faith life itself

- then reflect on how do we respond to such forces, are we naive to their agenda, are we passive to their concerted efforts to destabilize our devotions and our loyalty to the Lord through His church

- more importantly through introspection beware of the fact that whether we earnestly pray for the increase of His Kingdom or do we just go with the flow of the world and criticize those who pray for the conversion of nonbelievers Secularists vehemently object any attempt to invite others to believe in Jesus. Don't ignore the negotiating power of satan who is never at rest We follow the

command of the Lord, " harvest is plenty ... pray for more laborers ..." " go out to the ends of ... proclaim the good news .. baptize ... "

- the pervasive influence of secularism can be seen top to bottom in the church which is responsible for the retardation of the missionary zeal in the global church. They will appear very modern and say that we have to be friends with other religions.

Friendship is not a substitute for Faith. Careful not to confuse one with other. Do we want to please the Lord or the world. We can please the Lord very politely without offending nonbelievers.

Unlike certain other religions Jesus never prompted any violence against anyone.

- Finally when we see the destructive power of the secular agenda against our families, our morality, relationships, our very faith itself do we turn to the Lord in prayer for a sense of security and accelerate our longing for the Eternal Life in His glory - if we do so, persecution, martyrdom, insecurity due to revolutions or even war itself cannot destroy our longing for the great reward in Heaven.

It is this faith that helps us to make a difference in this age. We can do that only if we stay closer to Jesus every day in prayer and devotions. We must discuss such things with our children

and get them active in faith . Do not be shy or afraid. Our success is in His hands, our strength is in His presence with us, our wisdom is kindled by His Spirit in us. Through our loyalty to Jesus and His teachings the Heavenly Father will be pleased.


Es esta fe la que nos ayuda a marcar la diferencia en esta época. Podemos hacer eso solo si nos mantenemos más cerca de Jesús todos los días en oración y devociones. Debemos discutir tales cosas con nuestros hijos y hacer que se activen en la fe. No seas tímido ni tengas miedo. Nuestro éxito está en Sus manos, nuestra fuerza está en Su presencia con nosotros, nuestra sabiduría es encendida por Su Espíritu en nosotros. A través de nuestra lealtad a Jesús y Sus enseñanzas, el Padre Celestial estará complacido. Dios los bendiga a todos.

The man who hung on the cross next to Jesus asks him to "remember me when you come into your kingdom." Of all the people who took part in the crucifixion of Jesus, only this man sincerely acknowledges Jesus as King. Only he receives the promise of joining Jesus in paradise that very day. I wonder if he knew what Jesus' kingdom meant?

The second reading gives us a better idea of the extent of that kingdom. Paul uses images of things visible and invisible, of dominions, principalities, and powers. Notice one short phrase that appears six times in that reading: "all things." If Christ is King of all things, that includes our possessions. We might keep that in mind, not only when deciding how much we give to the poor or to the Church, but also how we use the things we own. The things we watch on TV, the foods we eat, the books we read—all are under Jesus' kingship. I might even drive more carefully if I remember that my car belongs to the Lord.

Even our life is under his reign. That can remind us to trust Jesus more, as well as to ask for the guidance of his Spirit in our decisions. If we let the Lord guide our lives, we know that anything that happens to us is either God's will or something that Jesus can lead us through, on our way to paradise.

**Last Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Almighty ever-living God,

**Reflection question:**

In what ways can I proclaim God's praise in the coming week?

**THE TRUE KINGSHIP OF JESUS CHRIST**

What kind of King is Jesus? How do you envision him? Remembering that they were promised a king from the line of David, the Israelites hoped for a Messiah who would set their political problems aright and bring about a worldly kingdom of Judaic power. Even Psalm 122 seems to describe this type of ruler. Luke's Gospel today shreds that image after the whip of the Roman soldiers tore at Jesus' flesh. Still, the Romans flaunted the traditional notion with their ironic inscription above King Jesus' crown of thorns. Soldiers and ordinary people jeered the royal title at him. Yet the throne of Jesus was the cross of Christ, from which he dispensed kingly mercy and justice toward the humble criminal who shared his execution. Writing to the Colossians, Saint Paul describes the truth about Jesus and his kingship, using words like fullness, peace, and forgiveness. So let us go rejoicing! Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

**LA VERDADERA REALEZA DE JESUCRISTO**

¿Qué clase de Rey es Jesús? ¿Cómo te lo imaginas? Recordando que se les prometió un rey del linaje de David, los israelitas esperaban a un Mesías que arreglara sus problemas políticos y trajera un reino terrenal de poder judaico. Incluso el salmo 122 parece describir este tipo de gobernante. El Evangelio de Lucas de hoy destruye esta imagen después de que el látigo de los soldados romanos desgarrara la carne de Jesús. Sin embargo, los romanos hicieron alarde de esa noción tradicional con la inscripción irónica en el letrero que pusieron sobre la cabeza de Jesús que está coronada con espinas. Los soldados y la gente de a pie se burlaban de su título de realeza. Sin embargo, el trono de Jesús era la cruz de Cristo, desde la que administraba misericordia y justicia majestuosa hacia el criminal humilde que compartía su ejecución. Al escribir a los colosenses, san Pablo describe la verdad sobre Jesús y su realeza, utilizando palabras como plenitud, paz y perdón. Así que ¡vamos a alegrarnos!




