From the Pastor's Desk / Del Escritorio del Padre

The New Year poses very demanding challenges on the most important aspects of our life, the family and the person. How efficiently and successfully we deal with these two will have its precipitating bearing on the third aspect of our life, our faith family. Challenges on the family are many faceted. Firstly is marriage for entertainment, a self satisfying sexual enjoyment and socioeconomic privileges? Here family becomes a business where profit motive and selfish interests dominate lives.

Liberated from the traditional moral concepts, proponents are heavily investing, like same sex marriage movement, economically and ideological propaganda for making it "normal" universally. They would not discuss resultant health issues, unhealthy emotional and spiritual consequences. Secondly Traditional marriage is for mutually satisfying emotional and physical intimacy leading to exclusive and lifelong commitment and fidelity. Unavoidable essential ingredients are, guiding moral principles, inspiring spiritual and devotional practices, practicing and raising children in prayer and faith where love , trust , respect and caring for one another evoke positive attitudes that are spontaneous to every person. There is a polarization from selfishness to self effacing nature. This is where Christian families truly follow Jesus. Such families become web of the society. If prayer and devotions and not restored quickly our families will be disintegrated soon. Devil is tirelessly at work to destroy the foundational values of this family through social media and entertainment world that promote and normalize pornography, immoral and licentious lifestyle, infidelity and irreligious attitudes. Most efficient tools of devil are drug,

substance abuse and pornography addictions which are plaguing everyone today especially younger generation. Most of the challenges on family are the same for persons. If we do not grow in a loving caring family with a sense of belonging it will be hard to develop a personal devotion to God. Absence of such atmosphere will precipitate dysfunctional behaviors and abnormal characters . This has devastating consequences to family and the society. There was a time when kids look up to saints, great thinkers and writers, social leaders and heroes of

society as role models for inspiration and character development. Today they are constantly exposed to immoral characters and activities, unorthodox values and models which are addictive and confusing them the influence of which is interfering with their proper self development. If parents and society fail to address them timely we will loose a future generation. These challenges to family and persons and their resolve will directly impact faith family. When families ignore

prayer and devotions but are mainly concerned about entertainment children will not have proper spiritual foundation and Christian character formation. Devil will constantly succeed in capturing their minds and lives. At Christmas we rejoiced that God is with us, then are we on the side of God or devil? Jesus sacrificed His life for our salvation but are we willing to adopt sacrifices that will help us to establish a personal intimacy with

Jesus and foster our discipleship journey to receive that salvation ? Do we listen to and let the Spirit of the Lord to inspire us or ruthlessly yield to the enticing spirit of the world? Are we ashamed to form a community of faith at home and in the church and to courageously testify to the truth of the saving presence of the Risen Lord in our lives ?

These are the blunt challenges on us during the New Year 2023. God bless you all

El Año Nuevo plantea retos muy exigentes sobre los aspectos más importantes de nuestra vida, la familia y la persona. Cuán eficiente y exitosamente tratemos con estos dos tendrá su influencia precipitante en el tercer aspecto de nuestra vida, nuestra familia de fe. Los desafíos en la familia tienen muchas facetas. En primer lugar, ¿es el matrimonio para el entretenimiento, un disfrute sexual autosatisfactorio y privilegios socioeconómicos? Aquí la familia se convierte en un negocio donde el afán de lucro y los intereses egoístas dominan la vida. Liberados de los conceptos morales tradicionales, los defensores están invirtiendo fuertemente, como el movimiento del matrimonio entre personas del mismo sexo, en propaganda económica e ideológica para hacerlo "normal" universalmente. No discutirían

los problemas de salud resultantes, las consecuencias emocionales y espirituales no saludables. En segundo lugar, el matrimonio tradicional es para una intimidad emocional y física mutuamente satisfactoria que conduce a un compromiso y una fidelidad exclusivos y de por vida. Los ingredientes esenciales ineludibles son los principios morales rectores, las prácticas espirituales y devocionales inspiradoras, la práctica y la crianza de los niños en la oración y la fe donde el amor, la confianza, el respeto y el cuidado mutuo evoquen actitudes positivas que son espontáneas para cada persona. Hay una polarización del egoísmo a la naturaleza modesta. Aquí es donde las familias cristianas verdaderamente siguen a Jesús. Tales familias se

convierten en la red de la sociedad. Si la oración y las devociones no se restablecen rápidamente, nuestras familias pronto se desintegrarán. Devil trabaja incansablemente para destruir los valores fundamentales de esta familia a través de las redes sociales y el mundo del entretenimiento que promueven y normalizan la pornografía, el estilo de vida inmoral y licencioso, la infidelidad y las actitudes irreligiosas. Las herramientas más eficientes del diablo son las adicciones a las drogas, el abuso de sustancias y la pornografía, que afectan a todos hoy en día, especialmente a las generaciones más jóvenes. La mayoría de los desafíos en la familia son los mismos para las personas. Si no crecemos en una familia cariñosa y cariñosa con un sentido de pertenencia, será difícil desarrollar una devoción personal a Dios.

La ausencia de tal atmósfera precipitará comportamientos disfuncionales y caracteres anormales. Esto tiene consecuencias devastadoras para la familia y la sociedad. Hubo un tiempo en que los niños admiraban a los santos, grandes pensadores y escritores, líderes sociales y héroes de la sociedad como modelos a seguir para la inspiración y el desarrollo del carácter.

Hoy en día están constantemente expuestos a personajes y actividades inmorales, valores y modelos heterodoxos que les generan adicción y confusión, cuya influencia interfiere en su adecuado desarrollo personal. Si los padres y la sociedad no los abordan a tiempo, perderemos una generación futura. Estos desafíos para la familia y las personas y su resolución impactarán directamente a la familia de fe. Cuando las familias ignoran la oración y las devociones, pero se preocupan principalmente por el entretenimiento, los niños no tendrán el fundamento espiritual

adecuado ni la formación del carácter cristiano. El diablo constantemente logrará capturar sus mentes y vidas. En Navidad

nos regocijamos de que Dios está con nosotros, entonces ¿estamos del lado de Dios o del diablo? Jesús sacrificó Su vida por nuestra salvación, pero ¿estamos dispuestos a adoptar sacrificios que nos ayudarán a establecer una intimidad personal con Jesús y fomentar nuestro camino de discipulado para recibir esa salvación? ¿Escuchamos y dejamos que el Espíritu del Señor nos inspire o cedemos despiadadamente al espíritu tentador del mundo? ¿Nos avergonzamos de formar una comunidad de fe en el hogar y en la iglesia y de testimoniar valientemente la

verdad de la presencia salvadora del Señor Resucitado en nuestras vidas? Estos son los desafíos contundentes que se nos presentan durante el Año Nuevo 2023. Dios los bendiga a todos

Almost every year at Christmastime, you can find a newspaper article or TV documentary about the star of Bethlehem. Astronomers give various theories about whether the magi saw a supernova, or a comet, or a conjunction of two or more planets. But for us, the star has a deeper meaning. In Matthew's Gospel, light is used as a symbol of the good news of Jesus coming into the world. That's why verse 9 of the Gospel has the image of the star preceding the wise men and stopping over the house where Jesus was. By following the star, they become followers of Christ.

So what do the magi show us about following Jesus? First, they take the initiative. They saw the star, figured out what it meant, and made their journey. As followers of Jesus, we can look for what needs to be done (in our family, parish, or community) and do it.

Second, they expressed their faith in Jesus by the gifts they brought: gold—a gift for a king, who is worthy to be followed; frankincense—Jesus is worthy to be worshiped as Son of God; and myrrh—Jesus becomes king by dying for us all. We can express our faith in many ways. We can volunteer to help the poor, the elderly, or the disabled. We can teach our children how to pray and tell them about all that God has done for us.

Third, they were not afraid to take risks for Jesus. How often do we take risks for the Lord, by openly speaking about our faith, or giving God credit for the good that we do? Let the star of Bethlehem remind us that Jesus is the star of our lives.

OUR FASCINATING FAITH

Epiphany House Blessing

If you wish, you can celebrate Epiphany at home with a blessing using the initials of the magi's traditional names (Casper, Melchior, Balthasar), four crosses, and the new year's numerals.

Materials: a piece of chalk and a small container of holy water. Gather with family members, friends, and perhaps some neighbors at the front door.

Leader: In the (+) name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

We sign this doorway with four crosses and the numerals of the new year. [20 + C + M + B + 23]

Let us pray: May Christ bless this house!

ALL: Amen!

Each room of the house is sprinkled with holy water.

Living room:

Where two or three are gathered in your name, Lord, you are present. Bless this room, O Lord.

ALL: Amen!

Kitchen:

Give us this day our daily bread. Bless this room, O Lord.

ALL: Amen!

Dining room:

Prepare us for the heavenly banquet. Bless this room, O Lord.

ALL: Amen!

Bedrooms:

Stay with us Lord, when night has come. Bless this room, O Lord.

ALL: Amen!

Bathroom:

Cleanse us from all sin. Bless this room, O Lord.

ALL: Amen!

All return to the front door to pray together.

Leader: Let us pray as Jesus taught us:

Our Father . . .

The leader sprinkles all present with holy water.

Bless this household through all days to come, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, forever and ever.


